- 1. All passenger ships, including high-speed passenger crafts, cargo ships, including high-speed craft of 300 gross tonnage and upward and mobile offshore drilling units shall be fitted with a Long-range identification and tracking of ships (LRIT).
- 2. All ships of 300 gross tonnage and upwards engaged on international voyages and cargo ships of 500 gross tonnage and upwards not engaged on international voyages and passenger ships irrespective of size shall be fitted with an automatic identification system (AIS).

CONTENT

Any Belize Flagged Vessel that intentionally deactivate the Long-range Identification and Tracking equipment (LRIT) and/or the Automatic Identification System (AIS) will be subject to disciplinary actions in accordance with regulations 7 (Fines) and 8 (Cancellation of Registration or Documents) of the Statutory Instrument 156 of 1999 – Disciplinary Regulations.

SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

The LRIT and AIS can only be switched off or deactivated under the following special circumstances:

- 1. When a ship is undergoing repairs, modifications or conversions in dry-dock or in port or is laid up for a long period, the master or the Administration may reduce the frequency of the transmission LRIT information to one transmission every 24-hour period, or may temporarily stop the transmission of such information. Regulation 4.4.1 of IMO Resolution MSC.263(84) Revised Performance Standards and Functional Requirements for the Long-Range Identification and Tracking of Ships (LRIT).
- 2. When the master believes that the continual operation of AIS might compromise the safety or security of his/her ship or where security incidents are imminent. Regulation 22 of IMO Resolution A.1106(29) "Revised Guidelines for the Onboard Operational Use of Shipborne Automatic Identification Systems (AIS).

Prior the switching off or deactivation of the LRIT and AIS, a written notification must be submitted by owner/operator to IMMARBE Technical Department (technicalofficer@immarbe.com, technicalofficer@immarbe.com and techsupport@immarbe.com) explaining the reasons and period of this action. A proper

written authorization will be granted by the Technical Department.
